2027 USA Badminton Junior National Championships

1. Introduction

USA Badminton (USAB) invites qualified host organizations, sports commissions, convention and visitors bureaus (CVBs), municipalities, and local organizing committees to submit proposals to host the USA Badminton Junior National Championships.

The Junior National Championships represent the premier annual competition for junior badminton athletes in the United States. The event brings together the nation's top junior players, coaches, officials, and families for a week of national championship competition while serving as an important component of the athlete development pathway.

USAB seeks host partners capable of delivering a world-class championship experience through exceptional facilities, strong community support, operational excellence, and a commitment to growing the sport of badminton.

2. Event Overview

The USA Badminton Junior National Championships is a multi-day national championship featuring competition across multiple junior age divisions.

5. Facility Requirements

The proposed venue must include:

Competition Space

- Space for a minimum of 22 competition courts including appropriate safety run-off.
- Minimum ceiling height appropriate for national-level badminton competition but no less than 30 feet & free of obstructions.
- At least 150-foot candles of light on the participation surface.
- Any source of lighting behind the ends of the courts, such as a doorway, a window or a light fixture must be concealed during the competition.
- Background and wall colors providing sufficient contrast to a white shuttlecock.
- Climate-controlled environment for the entire duration of the event.

HVAC

Heating and air conditioning systems shall not create noticeable airflow across the courts.

Facilities must demonstrate either:

- Proper air distribution away from the playing area, or
- The ability to modify airflow during competition.

Flooring

Preferred flooring includes:

- Existing hardwood athletic flooring, or
- Suitable subfloor capable of supporting portable badminton courts.

Concrete floors without approved sport flooring will not be considered.

Spectator Seating

Adequate seating shall be provided for athletes' families, coaches, and spectators while maintaining safe circulation throughout the venue.

6. Venue Infrastructure

The venue must provide:

- Loading dock suitable for trailer deliveries
- Forklift or equivalent unloading equipment
- Secure overnight equipment storage
- Dedicated registration area
- Tournament operations office

- Officials' lounge office
 - Medical treatment room (open & observable)
 - Access to a defibrillator
 - Awards presentation area
 - Vendor and merchandise space
 - At least 10 (ten) tables and 140 (one hundred forty) chairs
 - Public announcement sound equipment
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7. Technology Requirements

The venue shall provide reliable technology infrastructure including:

- High-speed wireless internet throughout the venue
- Dedicated secure event network for tournament operations
- Sufficient bandwidth to support:
 - Live scoring
 - Livestreaming
 - Staff operations
 - Public Wi-Fi

Reliable cellular service throughout the venue is strongly preferred.

8. Parking & Transportation

The proposed venue shall include:

- Parking for approximately 750 passenger vehicles
- Designated parking for volunteers and officials
- Dedicated parking for up to two semi-trailers
- Accessible parking compliant with ADA requirements

Preferred:

- Convenient rideshare access
 - Public transportation options
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9. Hotels & Hospitality

Host communities shall demonstrate adequate hotel capacity within approximately fifteen (15) minutes of the competition venue.

Preferred accommodations include:

- Multiple price points
- Family-friendly properties
- Complimentary breakfast options
- Meeting space for tournament operations

Walkable access between hotels, restaurants, and the venue is highly desirable.

10. Airport Access

The host city should be served by a major commercial airport with domestic and international service.

Preference will be given to communities located within approximately thirty (30) minutes of the airport.

11. Food & Beverage

Hosts shall identify food service options including:

- Venue concessions
- Nearby restaurants
- Staff & Officials catering services

Communities offering diverse dining options are encouraged. We require vegetarian options to be available through concessions and staff & official catering services for the duration of the event.

12. Community Support

Each proposal must demonstrate significant local support.

Required:

- Participation from a minimum of two local badminton clubs
- A Local Organizing Committee with a designated local point of contact
- Volunteer recruitment plan
- Letters of support from key partners

Preference will be given to communities with established badminton participation and a demonstrated history of supporting racket sports and youth sporting events.

13. Volunteer Program

The host shall recruit and manage volunteers to support:

- Registration
- Court management
- Hospitality
- Awards
- Venue operations
- Event equipment setup and teardown

Volunteer training plans should be included with the proposal.

14. Athlete & Family Experience

USA Badminton seeks hosts committed to providing an outstanding championship experience beyond competition.

Proposals should identify nearby:

- Restaurants
- Shopping
- Entertainment
- Museums
- Parks
- Cultural attractions
- Recreational activities

Communities offering unique experiences that enhance the visit for athletes and families will receive favorable consideration.

15. Climate

Preference will be given to locations with average daytime temperatures below 90°F (32°C) during the proposed event dates.

16. Financial Proposal

Bidders should clearly identify:

- Facility rental costs
- Catering costs, if applicable
- In-kind contributions
- Financial support from local agencies
- Sponsorship commitments
- Tourism grants
- Volunteer support
- Marketing support

 - Hotel Information
 - Transportation Plan
 - Parking Plan

 - Local Attractions Summary
 - Primary Contact Information
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18. Submission Instructions

Electronic proposals shall be submitted in PDF format.

Proposals should be organized according to the sections outlined in this RFP.
